### Spot On: Women + Culture + Work

Working in the cultural sector is rarely straightforward. Beyond talent and qualifications, it demands patience, organizational skills, network building, flexibility, and steadfast determination. Berlin's cultural landscape relies in no small part on the strengths and abilities of women who manage to embody these things every day. 34 of them appear in this exhibition.

These 34 women represent a broad spectrum of the cultural sector: actors, musicians, museum workers, a dancer, a textile artist, a painter, a bookseller, and many more. They are at different stages in their careers and work both independently and in steady employment. They live alone or with partners; many have children, but many do not. Included are artists already in the spotlight as well as women whose work receives hardly any public recognition. With this exhibit they all take center stage: through photographic portraits and interviews about their daily lives, experiences, and ideas for structural change.
